Club Rules

I. Use of Club Facilities

Parking Facilities:

The General Committee shall extend full parking privileges to Life, Special, Senior and Country Members. The availability of parking privileges for all other classes of membership shall be limited by the General Committee having regard for:

- (a) The objects of the Club.
- (b) The need to maximise the availability of parking facilities for Life, Special, Senior and Country members.
- (c) The nature of activities being conducted at the Club from time to time.

2. Annual Membership Subscriptions

- (a) The entrance fees and annual subscriptions for all categories of Membership are specified in Annexure A.
- (b) For entrance fees and subscriptions based on age, the Member's age as at the 1st July in any year shall be the determinant of the liability.
- (c) Applicants and Members seeking or holding categories of membership based on age will be required to provide evidence of date of birth at the time of making the initial application.
- (d) Applicants and Members seeking or holding categories of membership based on full dependency, full time student status and membership of kindred clubs will be required to provide evidence of that status annually.
- (e) A Senior Member, or an applicant for Senior Membership, may apply to the General Committee to have his or her liability for entrance fees and annual subscriptions, and those of his or her immediate family who are applicants for Membership or Members in their own right, reduced to that applicable to a Family Membership Grouping.

A Family Membership Group may consist of any number of Members of the following categories:

- (i) One Senior Member (known for the purpose of this grouping as the Primary Family Member);
- (ii) One Associate Member who is the partner of the Primary Family Member;
- (iii) Junior Members who are the son or daughter of the Primary Family Member or Partner.
- (f) The Primary Family Member of a Family Membership Grouping is responsible for the financial liabilities of all of the constituent members of the Grouping.
- (g) The entrance fee and annual subscription for the Family Membership Grouping is based on the sum of the entrance fees and annual subscriptions for one Senior Member 25 years of age and over and one Associate Member – Partner.
- (h) An Associate Member - Social or an Associate Member - Crew, or an applicant for either category of membership, may apply to the General Committee to have his or her liability for entrance fees and annual subscriptions, and all of his or her immediate family who are applicants for Junior Membership under 15 years of age in their own right, reduced to that applicable to a Parent and Children Membership Grouping.

2. Annual Membership Subscriptions - cont'd

- (i) The Associate Member – Social or an Associate Member – Crew of a Parent and Children Grouping is responsible for the financial liabilities of all of the constituent members of the Grouping.
- (j) No entrance fee is payable by the constituent member of the Parent and Children Grouping. The annual subscription for the Parent and Children Membership Grouping is based on the sum of the annual subscriptions for one Associate Member – Social and one Junior Member under 15 years of age.
- (k) All members of Membership Groupings must be Members of the Club in their own right.

3. House Support Scheme

- (a) The account of each Senior Member, as defined in the Constitution, shall be debited with the amount specified in Annexure A Redeemable Credits on the first of January, April, July and October in each year. The General Committee has the discretion to waive House Support Credits for Members in such circumstances and for such periods as it deems appropriate.

On payment of that amount, the member shall be issued with a credit on their members account to the same value.

- (b) The account of each Senior Dinghy and Crew Member shall be debited with the amount specified in Annexure A Redeemable Credits on the first of January and July in each year. On payment of that amount, the member shall be issued with a credit on their members account to the same value.
- (c) This credit is redeemable from the Club for the purchase of any goods or services except:
 - (i) Membership subscriptions and fees;
 - (ii) Boating accommodation fees including pens and hardstanding;
 - (iii) Fuel;
 - (iv) Any other goods or services that do not support the promotion of objectives of the Club.

Each issue of credit shall be valid for redemption within six months of the date the members account was debited provided that members shall, each July, be provided with the option to pay an amount equal to one year's House Support Scheme Credits upon payment of which, in full, a credit for the amount shall be valid for redemption within twelve months of the date the members account was debited.

Payment for House Support Scheme Credits shall be dealt with as a debt to the Club under the Constitution.

Schedule of Entrance Fees and Annual Subscriptions Effective 1st July 2017 - cont'd

Redeemable House Support Scheme Credits

Senior Members: \$125 is charged every three months (July, October, January and April)

Senior Dinghy Members: \$125 is charged every six months (July and January)

Crew Members: \$125 is charged every six months (July and January)

If the credits are not redeemed within six months, or, where in accordance with Clause 4.3 a Member has paid one year's worth of House Support Scheme Credits in advance, twelve months, they will be invalid.

There will be no exception to this rule.

These credits are redeemable from the Club for the purchases of any goods or services except::

- i Membership subscriptions and fees*
- ii Boating accommodation fees including pens and hardstanding*
- iii Fuel*
- iv Any other goods or services that do not support the promotion of objectives of the Club*

Trophy Collections:

Senior members will be debited \$11 and junior members will be debited \$5.50 annually to contribute to trophy costs.

Members will be charged for a Club Book (\$30) and Club Burgee (\$45).
