Dear Marine Safety partner,

The Department of Transport (DoT) is conducting a review of safety equipment required for all recreational vessels (e.g. boats, personal water craft, sailboards etc.) on all WA waters including inland waters, rivers, lakes and ocean waters.

The review will be conducted in two stages. The first stage began on Saturday 27 May with the release of an on-line public survey and a supporting discussion paper; the *Recreational Vessel Safety Equipment Discussion Paper – Summary*. This supporting paper, among other things, describes how the review will be conducted.

The DoT Marine Safety team seeks your assistance to inform the public about the review. We invite as many people as possible to provide their feedback to the review before **Monday 10 July 2017**.

Accompanying this letter is a pack containing brochures. As one of our Marine Safety partners we would appreciate very much if you would display the brochures for the public to take.
