Temporary Guest Cards

Guest cards will be available in the bar, from 15 November. Members, who are accompanying guests, may request up to five of the Guest Cards and these will enable members' guests to purchase food and beverage in the bar at the same price as members during their visit to the Club. Members who wish to take advantage of these cards will need to ask for the Guest Cards at the bar. The bar person will record your name and membership number.

Members will then be able to provide a card for their guests to use when they purchase drinks and meals. The Temporary Guest Cards are to be returned to the bar before your guests leave the Club. Temporary Guest Cards will only be active until the close of business on the day of issue.

Boating Accommodation Guide (BAG)

Recent changes to the BAG permits a Junior, who hold a skipper's ticket, to hold a pen and operate a boat within the Club's marina.

Boat pens, moorings and hardstand bay may now be held by financial Life, Special and Senior Members or a junior member who hold a skippers ticket. Junior, Senior Members 18-21 and 21-24 will be required to pay an additional membership fee equal to that of a Senior Members 25 and over and Junior Members must also have a parent or guardian responsible for all financial accounts.

Boats occupying Club accommodation can only be operated within the Club facilities by:-

- The Member allocated the accommodation or a person lawfully operating the boat in the presence of that Member.
- A Junior, or a Senior Member between the ages of 18-25, who holds a Skippers ticket and with the permission of the member allocated the boating accommodation
- Authorised Service providers, or Licensed Skippers (Boatman) employed by the Owner and who are registered with the club.
