**Re: Swan River Channel closure lifted**

Please be advised from **Saturday 30 June**, the Swan River navigation channel between Burswood and East Perth will be available to all river users between **5.30am and 5.30pm daily**.

Some restrictions and spotter vessels will continue to be in the area during the day, but access will be provided to all users.

At night between **5.30pm and 5.30am** the navigation channel will **remain closed** for approximately three more weeks.

We continue to seek cooperation from skippers and other river users to follow the instructions from spotter vessel crews at all times, as hazards such as cables and anchor lines remain in the river and may not be readily identified without guidance.
