Views from the Poop Deck - ANZAC Day Race

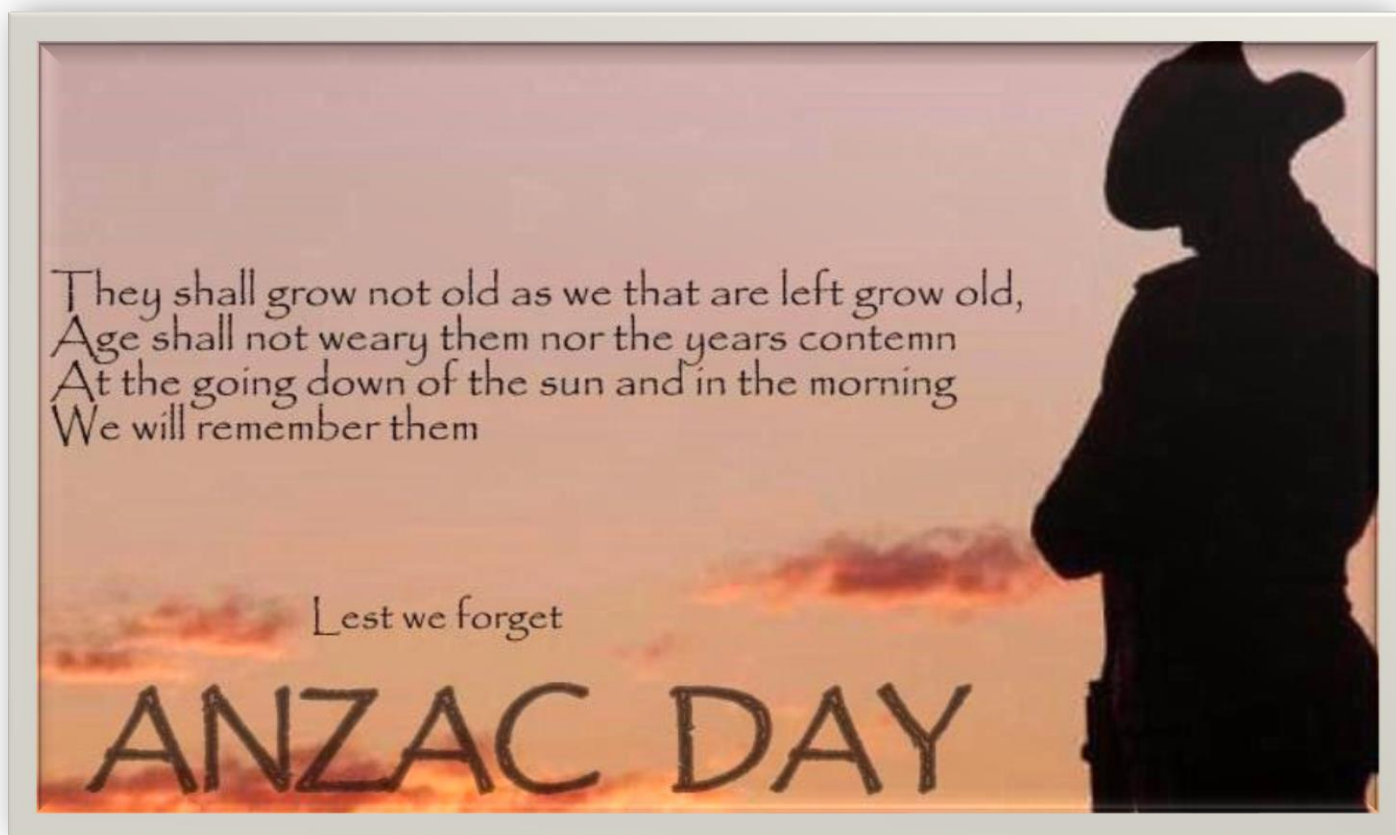
