

## **AMENDMENT TO Notice of Motion to amend the Constitution to revise the provisions for calling General Meetings of members and for proposing amendments to the Constitution and Rules.**

In accordance with clause 14(a) of the constitution of the Claremont Yacht Club (Inc.), I hereby give notice that I will move the following amendment to the proposed motion to amend clauses 9 & 14 of the Constitution to be presented to the Annual General Meeting of Members of the Club, to be held in the Clubhouse on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> September 2019.

### **Explanation:**

The motion as presented does not allow for a General Meeting of members to make Rules, although it does allow for amendment of the Rules of the Club. Retaining clauses 14(b)(i) and part of 14(b)(ii) makes it plain that new rules may also be added to, and rules deleted from, the Rules of Claremont Yacht Club

**MOTION** : That the proposed motion to amend Clause 9 and Clause 14 be amended by NOT deleting clause 14(b)(i) and NOT deleting part of clause 14(b)(ii) as shown below.

14. Miscellaneous

(b) Rules:

- (i) Subject to sub clause 14(a), a General Meeting may, subject to this Constitution make rules binding upon all Members upon motion carried by a simple majority of voting Members present.
- (ii) Rules may be added to, amended or deleted as provided in clause 14(a).
